To improve biodiversity conservation in Latin America, the project aims to

- a) undertake collaborative research in the field of biodiversity conservation measures in Biosphere Reserves in Ecuador,
- b) elaborate on the basis of the research findings guidelines for practitioners concerning Adaptive Governance of Biodiversity in Biosphere Reserves and
- c) develop a higher education course about Biodiversity Governance in Biosphere Reserves, placing special emphasis in including the participation of local population in conservation issues.

The project will include local case studies and experiences in four selected biosphere reserves in Ecuador: the Galápagos Islands, Sumaco, Podocarpus-El Condor, and Yasuní.
