The University of Augsburg is looking for candidates with an excellent and internationally visible record in research and teaching. This includes above-average successful acquisitions of third-party funds. Candidates should be internationally recognized in the field of resilience, climate impact and climate adaptation research, preferably with a focus on agricultural or forest ecosystems.

The professorship should contribute significantly to the upcoming strategic center for climate resilience at the Augsburg University. The willingness to conduct interdisciplinary research in the field of climate resilience as well as the establishment and continuation of existing cross-faculty cooperation, e.g. with the 'Wissenschaftszentrum Umwelt (WZU)', is expected.

The tasks of the professorship include the active representation of human-environment research in teaching (including in digital format) at the Institute of Geography. Enthusiasm to actively participate in shaping the BSc, MSc and teacher training courses at the institute and participation in academic self-administration is required.

Requirements for the employment are a relevant university degree, pedagogical aptitude, the ability to do scientific work, which is usually verified by a doctorate, as well as the habilitation or proof of equivalent scientific relevant achievements, which may also have been achieved in the context of a junior professorship or outside academia.

An appointment to the civil service may only be made until the age of 52 (Art. 10 Abs. 3 Satz 2 BayHSchPG). Exceptions are only possible in exceptional cases.

The Augsburg University especially welcomes applications from qualified women as it is committed to increasing their representation in the professorial ranks.
